

# Gospel Harp



## Synopsis

A collection for diatonic, crosssharp, and chromatic harmonica. The gospel songs presented here are written as the song has been presented throughout the years. Key changes have been made to accommodate the harmonica. The first section is standard harmonica, key of C. The second section is in cross-harp (second) position. The third section uses a changed or retuned harmonica such as Lee Oskar's Melody Maker in G, or the Country Tuned Hohner Harmonica in C. Written in standard notation and tablature for diatonic and chromatic harmonicas with lyrics and chord symbols. Includes 91 tunes such as The Old Rugged Cross; The Love of God; In the Garden; He's Got the Whole World in His Hands; Oh, When the Saints Go Marching In; This Train Is Bound For Glory; His Eye is on the Sparrow; and much more.

I've never written a review before, but I felt this needed to be said. I'm new to the harmonica, and have been looking for a gospel songbook. Since this one is my first, it wasn't a huge deal, but I COULD NOT find any actual list of all of the songs included in this book. Most of the ones I ran across listed 5 or 6 songs, then just tacked on "and many more." So below you'll find a complete list of what songs you actually get. All 3 sections can be played on a C chromatic harmonica, but as for diatonic harmonicas you'll need to refer to the specific section that matches what kind of harmonica style you are using. Also, you might want to be aware that a few of the songs are in an abridged form -- some only featured the notes for the chorus and not the complete verses to the songs.

Overall, I'm happy with the book. It's definitely enough to get me started. I just felt that the product description didn't do the book justice.
