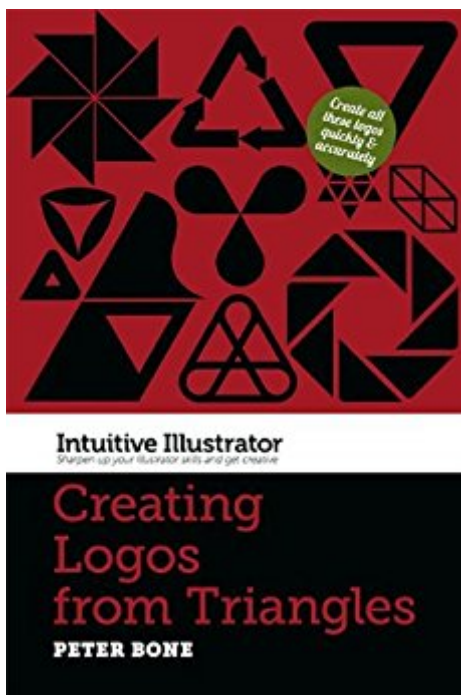

Along the way you'll learn key Illustrator skills such as how to align objects accurately, how to perform complex transformations and how to combine shapes in a variety of ways. Some of the specific tools you'll use will include the Reflect Tool, outlined strokes and Width Profiles. You'll also learn about different ways you can set up documents, how to create artwork that can be used in print or on the web, and how to work with spot colours, process colours and Pantone colours.
