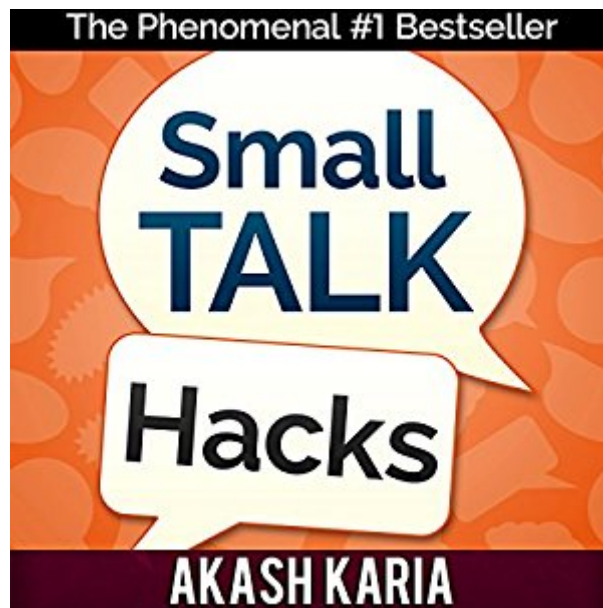

Full disclosure: I was given a free copy of this book for evaluation purposes. The sentiments in this review are my own, however. If I didn't like the book, I would not say I did. I am a big fan of Akash's. If you buy Akash's books, you should not expect deep, scholarly coverage of the subject matter. I have a bunch of those types of books, and they are seldom practical for the average person (like me) who just wants to apply the subject in my own life. Don't expect a comprehensive coverage of the art of small talk, along with endnote references to small talk-related peer-reviewed journals. Most authors of bad reviews of Akash's books seem to expect exactly that kind of book. What Akash writes are quick guides for those of us who want to learn how to quickly better ourselves in various areas - public speaking, book authoring, presentations, and now small talk - but we don't want to spend months reading a book. He does this wonderfully. He provides brief summaries of the different subject areas. My two favorite things about the book are: * He provides brief "try this" paragraphs at the end of each section. These provide simple, easily done exercises that lead you to some particular area. For example, he has a "try this" that says "If you struggle with making eye contact when you meet someone new, try turning it into a little game. Challenge yourself to pay attention to their eye color." This was an excellent hint that actually works! * He comes right out and says he's also an introvert and struggles with small talk. You don't get the impression that he's some great small talker; you get the feeling that he's just like us, and these tips and tricks are exactly what's helped him.
